Instructions to the candidates for Online Reporting to the Institute 07th - 13th December 2021

WELCOME TO ALL THE STUDENTS (ALLOTTED THROUGH JoSAA/CSAB- 2021) TO NIT ANDHRA PRADESH

All the candidates allotted to NIT Andhra Pradesh are required to report through **ONLINE MODE** during 07th (Tuesday) to 13th (Monday) December, 2021.

1. All the candidates (a) who have secured seat in the sixth round of JoSAA (who didn't participate in CSAB special rounds) or (b) will secure seat in the second round of CSAB (who are participating in the CSAB special rounds) MUST report to the NIT Andhra Pradesh through the ONLINE MODE during 7th to 13th Dec, 2021 to complete the provisional Admissions Process. During this process, the remaining fee has to be paid (if applicable) according to the details of the fee given below during 7th to 13th Dec, 2021 and allotted candidates are required to fill and submit the below-mentioned Google form.

- The candidates need to pay the following balance Institute fee (after adjusting the seat acceptance fee and Partial Admission Fee through JoSAA/CSAB) during 7th to 13th Dec, 2021.

 - b. Balance Institute Fee (SC, ST, PWD candidates) -Nil-
- 3. Institute fee has to be paid only through "State Bank of India i-collect". The fee can be paid online (Net banking) or offline at any SBI branch through the downloaded challan.

^{*} MEB- Most Economically Backward (Annual Income below 1 Lakh (maximum allowable Rs.99,999/-)); OEB -Other Economically Backward (Annual Income between 1 lakh to 5 Lakhs (Maximum allowable Rs.4,99,999/-)) candidates are required to pay full tuition fee (Rs.62,500/-) at the time of admissions. After verification of the income certificates the remission amount will be refunded back to the student. Separate notice will be issued for submitting documents regarding the Fee remission process and to claim the refund of excess fee paid by the candidates (if any).

NOTE: Caution deposits (Laboratory & Library deposit) is refundable at the time of leaving the institute after deducting dues, if any.

- 4. The reported candidates list will be published through Institute website during 7th to 13th Dec, 2021. Candidates are requested to visit the Institute website frequently to get the list of candidates.
- 5. The Induction Program and classwork will start from 15th December, 2021 through ONLINE MODE.
- 6. Tentative date of Commencement of physical mode classes is 3rd January, 2022.
- 7. All the Students are mandatorily required to get both doses of Covid-19 vaccine (or at least one dose) before reporting to the Institute Physically.
- 8. Hostel facility will be provided for all the candidates inside the campus. Separate notice regarding hostel registration process will be published through the Institute website by the Hostel Office.
- 9. Verification of original documents will be conducted in January 2022. Detailed schedule will be published through the Institute website. Students Must carry all the required original copies of the documents for verification purposes during Physical reporting to the Institute.

- 10. Fee Refund policy for the I B. Tech. seat cancellation/ Not Reported candidates as mentioned below:
 - If the seat is cancelled within fifteen days after the closing date of admission or not reported to the Institute after paying participation and seat acceptance fees, the Institute fee paid by the candidate will be refunded after deducting Rs. 27,500/-(Rupees twenty-seven thousand five hundred only) excluding the JoSAA/CSAB fees.
 - 2. If the seat is cancelled **after 15 days from the closing date of admission** the security deposits if any paid by the candidate only will be refunded.
